School Day

Kindergarten

8.00am - 1.30pm

Drop-off: 7.45am

Collection: 1.30 - 1.40pm

Primary

7.30am - 2.30pm

Drop-off: 7.15am

Collection: 2.30 - 2.40pm

Uniform

All items of school uniform are available through reception. They can be ordered from a variety of packages, or as individual items.

PE kit should be worn to school only on the days when the child has PE lessons

School Bag

All children require one bag only which they can carry by themselves. In the bag, they should place their lunch box and water bottle. Please do not use plastic bags.

All stationary and resource materials are provided for each child by the school, Therefore it is unnecessary to send these items to school.

As part of the Covid-19 protocols applied in the school, there is no sharing of food, drink, materials allowed. School books will not routinely be sent home.

Absences from School

Since the beginning of the pandemic when schools were forced to close on March 15th 2020, there has been an enormous amount of teaching and learning time lost. The various styles of educational experiences which children have received during this period will have had a significant effect upon their learning.

We will be providing every support possible to ensure that all our children are not disadvantaged by the effects of the pandemic in relation to their educational experience. We ask that all children arrive promptly at school every day and that absences which can be avoided by planning appointments outside of school hours are kept to a minimum.
